5. **New material is welcome.** I am always looking for new resources for my students. If you find a particularly nifty web site or web app about algebra, or a cool review site, or an interesting application of algebra to a real-world problem, I want to hear about it. If it advances our learning algebra I will post it on our wiki.

The Discussion feature is perhaps the most useful feature of this wiki. You students are welcome to weigh in on homework assignments, using on-line resources, quiz and test prep, MCAS prep, or anything that bears on algebra. Got a question about a Chapter Two homework problem? Go post it in the Chapter Two discussion forum; someone might have an answer for you. Or maybe YOU have an answer to someone else's question.

I welcome feedback, favorable and/or unfavorable, about this wiki: subject matter, features, utility, anything. With your help this wiki will be an ever-improving aid to learning.
